Zagare Vermentino, IGT Terre Siciliane (Italy)	13.5 %	3.5 / 5 / 6.5 / 18
Vermentino bursting with citrus notes and a nutty finish. Cuts nicely through spice. Dig it.		
Il Badalisc Pinot Grigio (It)	12.5%	3.5 / 5 / 6.5 / 19
The label depicts the Badalisc, a mythical horned Alpine creature covered in goat skin with burning orange eyes, often seen outside Chillis takeaway around 2am.		
Te Merio , Marlborough (NZ)	13%	4 / 6 / 8 / 23
Clean and crisp New Zealand Sauvignon.

Picpoul de Pinet, Réserve de la Roquemolière (France)	10.5%	22
Soft, aromatic floral white from Languedoc-Roussillon - in the classic green bottle.		
Gymnasium Fritz Willi Riesling 2019 (Germany)	12.5%	25
Straight outta Mosel. Fragrant aromas of ripe apricots, citrus and apple.		
Castel del Lupo Pinot Grigio 'Della Ginestra' [Organic] 2019 (Italy)	12.5%	24
Pure, award winning, aromatic and crisp. Rest In Pinot.

2018 Sancerre Le Grand Rochoy Blanc, Domaine Laporte (Fr)	13%	60
Classically crafted, dry white Sauvignon Blanc from the left bank of the upper Loire. (Organic)		

2013 Pierre Bourée Puligny-Montrachet 2013 (Fr) **12.5%** **65**
Classic white Burgundy. A complex wine with lovely toasty notes and aromas of hazelnuts and savoury buttery characters. Deeply yellow and deeply moving.

STRANGER THINGS

Uva Non Grata Gros Manseng (France) **12.5%** **19.5**
Thick-skinned and wild, Gros Manseng is relatively unknown. Zingy, incense-smoked and glorious, it's one of the fruitiest and fun wines you're likely to taste.
IWSC Bronze.

Melon Blanc Vendange Nocturne - Muscadet (France) **11%** **25**
A mega, modern, vibrant expression of Muscadet. Green melon fruit flavours and harvested at moonlight by witches.
Sustainable, Organic.

Henners Native Grace Barrel Chardonnay 2018 (UK) 12% **30**
2018 was a glorious vintage in England, see for yourself with this limited edition 100% Chardonnay from East Sussex.
Sustainable.

Château Mercian Fuefuki Koshu Gris de Gris (Japan) 12.5% **32**
An exceptional expression of Japanese culture. Faint reddish-orange hue. Sweet and gentle aromas of apricot, apple compote, Darjeeling, old Rose with subtle vanilla notes. *Kampai!*

2017 Txakolina, Adur (Spain) **12.5%** **32**
Veering into uncharted waters, the little-known gem from the wilds of the Basque country is a pinpoint-sharp green apple and lemon laser beam. (*Upgrade from the Vinho Verde*)

Domaine Désiré Petit Blanc Savagnin AOP JURA Arbois 2015 (France) 14.5% **34**
This is a complex, powerful wine with a bright golden colour. Jura wines are distinct and not for the faint-hearted. Ideal for food matching, we love this bad boy with a hot, creamy curry.
Sustainable.

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ORANGE

Golden Mullet Fury' - Semillion Viognier (Fr) 12.9% **28**
It's a strawberry blonde bombshell of capsicum, guava and butterscotch on the nose with waxy, textured, almond, spicy and rich flavours throughout your mouth. Orange wine that's actually worth all the hype and still funkier than Rick James Jockstrap

Saint Orange no.2 (Slovakia) 13% **32**
A dry orange wine from a blend of Welshriesling, Rhine Riesling and Gewurztraminer from a single vineyard. Fragrant nose with apricots and stone fruits on the palate and lingering acidity.

PET NAT

Dark Side of The Moon 2019 (Slovakia) 12% **35**

TOKAJ BLEND of three white grapes - Welschriesling (40%) and Hárslevelű (Lipovina) (20%) and Furmint (60%), Dry white wine with intense botrytis notes on the nose and taste. Matúš is spearheading natural wine production in the region and along with two of his winemaking friends, started a group promoting this winemaking approach called Tokaj Underground.

Sustainable. Organic. Natural Wine.

Sedimentál Kapitola III. (Sv) 11% **32**

A dry skin-contact wine with a vivid yellow colour and fresh, juicy fruit on the nose and taste. Notes of green and red apples with banging acidity. *No Sulphites, Organic, Sustainable, Natural Wine.*

Partyzán Müller Thurgau (Sv) 12.5% **32**

A white petnat made from Müller Thurgau grapes which were hand harvested in organic-certified vineyards. Refreshing bubbles with the vivid aromas of Muller, stone fruits on the palate and juicy acidity. *No Sulphites, Organic, Sustainable, Natural Wine.*

Partyzán André (Sv) 12.5% **32**

A red petnat made from André grapes which were hand-harvested in organic-certified vineyards. The grapes were crushed, lightly pressed and the juice transferred to glass demijohns where natural fermentation took place. Rose bubbles with red berry notes and great acidity. *No Sulphites, Organic, Sustainable, Natural Wine.*

CHAMPAGNE

NV Brut Reserve, Taittinger 12.5% (Fr) **70**

Taittinger sits amongst the finest champagnes in the world.

NV Green Label Organic, Lanson 12.5% (Fr) **90**

Champagne from entirely organic grapes, packed with pears and peaches, with a fine spray of lemon on the finish. *Biodynamic.*

NV Grande Cuvee, Krug 12.5% (Fr) **190**

Rich, floral, outstandingly complex Champagne from a legendary House, with a toasty nose and flavours of fresh lemon.

ROSE

Lieux Perdus Pinot Noir Rosé, Pays d'Oc (France) 12% **3.5 / 5 / 6.5 / 19**

Pinot Noir rosé with substance and packed full of creamy red fruit flavours. Drink it on your favourite Manchester beach.

Côtes Catalanes Rosé Canon du Maréchal, Domaine Cazes 13% **28**

Lavender filled, Mediterranean Provence for warm, sun baked days, watercolour nights and the pissing northern rain.

Domaine Lafran-Veyrolles Bandol Rosé (France) 13% **38**

An exceptional wild rosé from a very old Bandol estate, scoring 95 points in Decanter's 2020 Rosé Panel Tasting.

PORT

Krohn Lagrima White Port 19% **4 - 50ml / 8 - 100ml**

Lágrima (meaning 'tears') is the sweetest style of white Port. An excellent solo Apertif, it really comes to life in a Port Tonic Cocktail. Tickety boo, were back in the Douro valley.

Reserve Ruby Port, Quinta De Crasto 20% **4 - 50ml / 8 - 100ml**

During many wars with the French over the years, when Claret and Red Wine were embargoed, The Rose & Monkey's clientele turned to sweet, strong Port. And got royally walloped on it.

Fonseca Ten Year Old Tawny 20% **5 - 50ml / 9 - 100ml**

Ten years of wood ageing has given this wine its characteristic tawny colour delicate nuttiness and hints of spice and fine oak. Fruit Cake in a glass.

Da Vero Biologico Nero d'Avola, DOC Sicilia (It) **10.5%** **3.5 / 5 / 6.5 / 18.5**
[Organic] 2020 Ripe aromas of black fruit and a hint of spice, Sicilian Nero D/Avola at a fantastic price.

2019 Cuma Organic Malbec (Arg) **13%** **4 / 6/ 8 / 23**
Made alongside the Aymara peoples of Argentina. Cuma means harmony, and pureness. Sort your karma out.

2016 Rioja Crianza, Ramón Bilbao (Spain) **14%** **4 / 6/ 8 / 23**
A medium red with hints of blueberry yoghurt. This one goes down easier than the Titanic.

CLASSIC STYLES

Sixty Clicks Shiraz Mataro, Victoria 2020 (Oz) **14%** **19**
SWA silver award. A really expressive, bright, contemporary aussie Shiraz, with a nod to Fear and Loathing on the label.

Showdown 'Man with the Ax' Cabernet Sauvignon (USA) **13.5%** **25**
Cabernet Sauvignon is King. Rich cassis fruit and a good lick of oak make this a plush, easy-drinking example of why it is so highly prized. *Sommelier Wine Awards 2019 Silver*

Estate Merlot, De Martino (Chile) **14%** **22**
Classic Spicy, Plummy and deep dark Merlot.

El Viejo del Valle Pinot Noir (Chile) **13.5%** **23**
An exciting find from the depths of Chile. Deliciously long, bright, textural Pinot from cold, stony vineyards deep in the Central Valley's old glacial riverbeds.

Chianti Classico DOCG, Campomaggio (2015) (It) **14%** **34**
Great with Fava beans.

DEEP CUTS

Casa da Passarella, Albanico. Touriga Nacional (Por) 13.5% **29**

This is . Marvelous. Noble and Robust, Portugal's finest grape variety is about to explode on the scene.. (try if you like Cab Sav.)

Mas d'Alcyon, Plan de Dieu, Côtes du Rhône Villages 2020 (Fr) 14.5% **26**

A heavenly, generous blend of Grenache and Syrah - Southern Rhône staples from well established organic vineyards in the Plan de Dieu.

2016 Cartoixa, Scala Dei, Priorat (Spain) 14.5% **65**

Founded in the 12th Century by Led Zeppelin monks who settled around the Holy Mountain. Shepherds told them that at night, they could see the Hells Angels climbing the Stairway to Heaven to meet Elvis (Scala Dei - Ladder of God). The result is a superb robust, rounded Priorat.

Château Fabre Gasparets, Corbières-Boutenac (Fr) 14% **32**

One of the finest vineyards in the Languedoc a unique blend of Grenache Noir, Syrah and Mourvèdre.

Sustainable, Organic.

2015 Barolo DOCG, Ascheri (It) 14% **55**

Roll around the forest floor like a Shakespearean nymph on acid with this top drawer Italian drama.

Venta La Ossa Tempranillo 2017 (Sp) 14.5% **32**

Venta La Ossa is seriously good Tempranillo and well worth 'bear'ing the brunt pricewise.

Domaine des Tourelles Red 2018 (Leb) 14% **24**

A hugely characterful, high altitude red from one of the founding Lebanese wineries. IWC GOLD.

Domaine Chante Cigale, Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge 2017 (Fr) 14% **65**

This is a traditional Châteauneuf-du-Pape serious and brooding and benefits from a little time to breath and open up.

Clos du Val Zinfandel 2019 (USA) 15% **40**

Big Zinfandel from one of the top producers in the Napa Valley. Deep garnet, the nose is a generous mix of stewed black fruits, warm toasted spices, dried fig and prune.

LIGHTER PICKS

Red Angel IGT, Pinot Nero Jermann(It) 14% **45**

STAFF PICK: High-quality Italian Pinot Noir. Fragrant, with rich blueberries and fruits of the forest on the nose.

Pierre Bourée Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2019 (Fr) 13% **38**

Beautiful Burgundy - Light, delicate garnet colour with earthy and strawberry fruit on the nose.

2018 Pinot Noir Réserve, Trimbach (Fr.) 14% **32**

From the ancient Trimbach Vineyards of Alsace, made only in the best years, less earthy than its Burgundian cousin.

Dolcetto d'Alba 'Pian Balbo' 2019(It) 12.5% **29**

Youthful and deep, like you. Think plum, cherry, violet, sweet spice and dried herbs. And TRY IT CHILLED, you old soul.
